Senior Screenings'



Approximately 80 residents at Carroll Terrace, Jarrett Terrace, Lee Terrace and Lippert Terrace participated in a vein screening in September.

The vein screening was done by Dr. Matthew P. Arvon from the West Virginia Vein and Skin Centers. The screening evaluated for evidence of blood clot in vein (DVT) current or past and evidence of chronic deep vein or superficial venous insufficiency. The screening looks for blockages in the veins and gives a rating of your chances of developing blood clots and if you should seek further treatment. It can also help evaluate if treatment of varicose and spider veins would be of benefit to the patient.
